

Koch, MSc, MS, is head of the Department of the National Prevention Program in the Federal Office of Public Health in Switzerland, where she oversees the development and implementation of the national prevention program to tackle chronic diseases and addiction disorders. She has an appointment as lecturer and research fellow at the Institute for Primary Care at the University of Zürich in the area of health services research & innovation. She also contributes as a visiting lecturer to Harvard Medical School, Department of Global Health. She spent as a Swiss Harkness Fellow in Health Care Policy and Practice, a year in the United States at Harvard University. Prior to this appointment, she was head of section in the Federal Office of Public Health and led the first comprehensive mental health program in Switzerland. Beside her management

roles, Koch worked in many advisory positions and has collaborated with the Swiss Government to develop the current health policy agenda 2020, supported private companies that champion the promotion of a healthy lifestyle by committing themselves with voluntary campaign pledge and supervised national campaigns. In her functions she gained much experience in multi-sector collaboration (e.g. public-private-partnerships) to change the economic, environmental, educational and societal conditions leading to better health and sustainability. He is also a management consultant and partner since 1987 in Mira International, a consulting firm providing management guidance to firms in a wide range of industries in the USA, Europe and India. His consulting work includes assignments for small, medium and large corporations on strategies to elevate corporate values, accelerate growth, and improve profitability. Her specific interests include industrial ecology, biomass and bioenergy, biofuels, and urban infrastructure. Dr. Spatari studied Chemical Engineering and received her Ph.D. in Civil Engineering from the University of Toronto. She currently represents Drexel in the NEWBio Consortium led by Penn State, which focuses on researching and producing the non-food biomass resources in the Northeast region. Her research on biomass resources and renewable energy extends to multiple U.S. and international projects, including in Uruguay and Israel. In 2013, she was an invited speaker at the National Academy of Engineering's Frontiers of Engineering meeting to speak on LCA of biomass conversion and she was the 2014 recipient of Drexel University's Louis and Bessie Stein Family Fellowship.



Mathis Wackernagel, Ph.D., is Co-Creator of the Ecological Footprint & President of Global Footprint Network (www.footprintnetwork.org), an international sustainability think-tank. The think-tank

focuses on bringing about a sustainable human economy in which all can live well, within the means of one planet. It proposes the Ecological Footprint, which measures how much nature we use, how much nature we have, as a tool for bringing ecological limits to the center of decision-making everywhere. Mathis has worked on sustainability on six continents and lectured at more than a hundred universities. From 2011-2014 Mathis was also a visiting professor at Cornell University. His awards include the 2015 IAIA Global Environment Award, the 2013 Prix Nature Swisssanto, the 2012 Blue Planet Award, the 2012 Binding-Prize for Nature Conservation, the 2012 Kenneth Boulding Memorial Award, the 2011 Zayed International Prize for the Environment, an honorary doctorate from the University of Bern, a 2007 Skoll Award for Social Entrepreneurship, a 2006 WWF Award for Conservation Merit, and the 2005 Herman Daly Award of US Society for Ecological Economics.



Nahid Mokhtari, PhD., Founder and Spokesperson for the Foundation for the Education of the Heart.

Dr Mokhtari spent her professional life as a scientist, researcher and medical educator, and has over 30 years management and leadership experience. Much of this time was spent in exploring the scientific bases and success of alternative pain medications. Complementary to her professional work, she pursued a variety of spiritual traditions to understand the origins and mitigation of physical pain and the pain of loneliness that many feel, which modern and alternative science has not been able to answer. In her exploration she came to understand much of the pain we experience is a result of the failure of our creative spirit to be free to express itself. She came to understand a creative spirit lies within each heart and if this creative spirit is not free to play in some way true to itself we will experience pain.

For the past 17 years, Dr Mokhtari has looked to blend the available scientific and spiritual aspects of her understanding to be an active spokesperson, teacher, educator, TV host producer, and radio commentator to communicate the understanding of this creative spirit and what it means for one's life. Her recent activities have been focused on the Psychological aspect of the creative spirits and its role in creating the human experience as a new species. Susan Patterson, Author, Speaker and Advocate in the Fight Against Human Trafficking

Like many of us, Susan Patterson has always been interested in protecting the environment. Her adult journey began as a foster, adoptive mother which got her involved in fighting Human Trafficking as the majority of victims are from the foster care system. She speaks to over 20,000 people a year on how they can get involved in the fight against Human Trafficking. Her book, "How You Can Fight Human Trafficking, Over 50 Ways to Join the Fight" outlines close to 100 actions an individual, faith community or service group could do to fight Human Trafficking. Her research into Human Trafficking led her to discover that over 2/3rds of all Human Trafficking is in the third world. As a result of global warming, in many parts of the third world, it is already getting too hot to grow food

making the poor, poorer so they sell their oldest child to the Human Traffickers so the rest of the family can afford to eat. While the Human Trafficking book includes actions one can take against Global Warming, the number of people who are interested in reading a book on taking action against Human Trafficking is limited. So Susan wrote a second book that has had tremendous appeal because of the title, which is "15 Minute Healthy, Organic Meals for Less Than \$10 a Day." While delivering on its promise of teaching one how to eat healthy on a budget, the book motivates one to use Fair Trade food products and be responsible for the environment because if it becomes too hot to grow food, the whole "let's eat organic" conversation becomes a mute point. The "food" book outlines many actions one can take in the fight against Global Warming.

Maya is a transmedia producer and emerging technology aficionado who applies the power of transmedia to world-changing ideas
