### **Summary of Legal activities**

Professor Elena Andreevska has been practicing public international law at the highest level for the Macedonian Government, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and at the academic level the past 30 years. Since 2001 until 2019 she was a Professor at the South East European University, Tetovo. She has participated in many bilateral and multilateral treaty-making activities ranging from the human rights and judicial cooperation. She also gave numerous legal opinions on the interpretation and application of provisions and legal issues arising from subsequent implementation or amendment of such treaty instruments.

She was in Oxford on the basis of her status as a “Recognized Student”, and Professor Ian Brownlie was appointed her Supervisor by the Board of the Faculty of Law in the University. Her main undertaking was the research “National Minorities in the Balkans under the European and UN System of Protection of Human and Minority Rights”. It is to be emphasized that her work was carried out under Professor Brownlie supervision.

Professor Elena has been active in promoting Macedonian’s interest in various aspects of international law and has also taken and an active part in the teaching and training university students and young colleagues in public international law and, particularly, in international human rights law. She regularly delivers lectures in South East European University, Tetovo in Macedonia and elsewhere.
